

Reverse Transfer

It is not unusual for students at a community college to transfer to a four year college or university before completing their requirements for an Associate's degree. Students may still be able to obtain their degree from Carl Sandburg College while taking classes at a different institution.

While the traditional method of transferring credits involves sending credits from a two- year to a four- year college/university, "Reverse Transfer" is a term which refers to sending earned credits that are obtained at a university to be transferred back to the community college in order to finish degree requirements. It is helpful to have a degree on your resume when pursuing employment opportunities.

Students who have completed at least 15 credit hours toward their degree at Carl Sandburg College may be eligible to pursue this option if some General Education courses have been completed successfully at a different institution.
